Who Can Participate?

When?

How Long?

Depending on the number of students in your school participating plan on 30-60 minutes. <u>Sample Schedule</u>:

Have participants arrive/checkin and be ready to go by your posted start time
5-10 minutes
10-20 minutes
5-10 minutes
5-10 minutes
Wrap up - Thank Supporters/Donors, Share any closing details, encourage them to watch local media and your social media for updates on how much your school raised and future community trainings.
